

Therapeutic Social Learning Summer Camps Description



Detectives Part 1 Level 2 Camp - July 4th-8th - 9:00-12:00 (ages 6-9)

This camp follows the Social Thinking® We Thinkers Curriculum, written by Kari Zweber Palmer, Nancy Tarshis, Ryan Hendrix and Michelle Garcia Winner. Your child will improve their social competencies by working together as a group with engaging themes every day like arts and crafts, games, scavenger hunts and many more.

<u>Creative Camp - July 11th-15th - 9:00-12:00 (ages 9-13)</u>

In this camp, your child will be creative with their peers and work on different projects such as arts and crafts and building materials such as Lego, K'nex or wood throughout the week. All by continuing to focus on your child's social emotional learning, self-regulation, executive functioning, perspective taking, and problem solving.



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Exploration Camp - July 4th, 6th, 7th, 11th, 13th, 14th - 1:00-3:30 (ages 12-16)

This camp will help children apply their social competencies within a group while out in the community. The children will plan their own outings which will focus on executive functioning. While we are out on excursions they will be focusing on self-regulation, social emotional learning, perspective taking and social problem solving.

Outings will be selected and planned by the group and may include: Bowling, Arcade, Museum, Mini Golf, Restaurant outing, Mall trip, Swimming, Skating





Detectives Camp Level 2 - Part 2 - August 22nd - 26th (ages 6-9)

In this camp we continue to follow the concepts in the We Thinkers Curriculum, a Social Thinking® curriculum, By working within a group your child will further develop social competencies that will allow them to work with others cooperatively by using engaging themes like photography, movies, cartoon animation and many more



<u>Imaginarium Camp - August 29th - September 2nd - 9:00-12:00 (ages 9-13)</u>



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This is a camp where children are encouraged to work together and share their imagination as they create stories, comic strips, role play and many more. By working together they will be improving their executive functioning, perspective taking, self-regulation and perspective taking.

Hollywood Camp - August 22nd, 24th, 25th, 29th, 31st, Sept. 1st - 1:00-3:30 (ages 12-16)

The first two days of camp the children will work together to write a small movie script. The rest of the week they will produce and act in the movie. The focus of this group will be on developing their social competencies such as executive functioning, perspective taking, conversations, social problem solving and self-regulation.
